

MOVING SNOW INTO ROADWAYS PROHIBITED ORDINANCE

- I. **PURPOSE.** To promote the safe and orderly passage of the motoring public, free from obstructions and obstacles created by a person depositing snow on a Town road.
- II. **AUTHORITY.** RSA 236:20, RSA 47:17, VII, and RSA 41:11.
- III. **DEFINITIONS.**

“**Snow**” means all forms of frozen precipitation, including snow, ice, sleet, hail, etc.

“**Town**” means The Town of Tuftonboro

“**Town Road**” means all Class V and Class VI highways (as defined in RSA 229:5) located within the Town.

“**Traveled Portion**” means any part of a Town Road, including shoulders, in which a motor vehicle could travel without hitting an obstacle (stone wall, tree, etc.).
- IV. **ACTS PROHIBITED.** It shall be unlawful to plow, snow blow, push, shovel or purposefully move or deposit in any manner snow into or across the traveled portion of any Town Road.
- V. **EXCLUSIONS.** This ordinance shall not apply to Town and State of New Hampshire vehicles engaged in wintertime road maintenance.
- VI. **PENALTY.** Any person who violates the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a violation and subject to a fine of \$50 per violation. Fines are payable within 5 business days at the Tuftonboro Police Station.
- VII. **ADOPTION.** This ordinance is adopted effective September 9, 2019.
