Directions to Moultonborough Library

From Interstate #93 Exit 23 go 9 miles east on Rt. 104 to Meredith. Turn left (down the hill) at lights onto Rte. 3 North. Go almost one mile to next set of lights (Lake Winnepesaukee will be on your right). Turn right at lights onto Rte. 25 East. Go approximately 5 miles to Center Harbor. Stay straight through 2 sets of lights on Rte. 25. Go approx. 4.5 miles to intersection of Rte. 25 and Rte. 109 (blinking light). Library is located on the left at the corner beyond the Old Country Store. Turn left onto Holland Street, then an immediate right into the library parking lot.

From intersection of Rte. 16 and Rte. 25 in Ossipee go 13.5 miles to Rte. 109 and 25.
