

Tuftonboro Conservation Commission
Minutes May 19, 2008

Meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM.

Commissioners present: Michael Phelps, Dawn Evans, Barbara Garabedian, Jerry Light.

Reminder of the LWVA roundtable Thursday from 4-6 PM; several members will be attending.

Phelps has not been able to touch base with the Browers as yet, since they have not returned.

Evans and Light attended the recent Planning Board meeting to discuss the formation of a Wetlands Committee. Light pointed out that there is extensive information online, and he has formulated some useful ideas. Evans is trying to line up speakers for a forum on June 12, including a wetlands expert and a wildlife biologist. Light will bring in suggestions for ordinances for discussion at the next meeting.

Garabedian is working on a Current Use warrant article, and collecting examples from other towns.

The TCC discussed possible candidates for the full time and alternate positions on the Commission. Interested parties should submit a letter of intent.
