**Lang Pond Rd.** relocation update

Tuftonboro is fifth on the list for state funding; total cost is estimated at \$400,000-\$500,000, the balance of which could be borrowed from the state at a low interest rate. A special town meeting is required to approve the plan.

**19 Mile Brook**

The TCC voted to increase the appropriation of funds for the ongoing project from \$5,000 to \$7,500; Leavitt-Carlson moved, Light second, all in favor.

Normandeau has recommended an interval of no more than a month between gage checks.
