Minutes of May 11, 2009 Meeting

Present: Members Eaton, Evans, Frago, Knapp, and Chair Lapolla

Absent: Members Young and Lawton

Also Present: Chief of Police Shagoury

The meeting was called to order at 7:10 PM

The minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed, and a motion to approve was made and seconded, with one abstention.

Conceptual drawings of the proposed police station addition were reviewed with discussion centering on room placement, size, etc. Chief Shagoury arrived during this discussion and gave his input on similar concerns. It was noted that these drawings are only conceptual, and final plans would be made by an architect appointed by the Selectmen and reviewed by the Fire and Police Chiefs prior to public presentation.

Committee member Knapp suggested an article be placed in the "Tuftonboro Times" to inform the public of our task, and the suggestions made by our committee. This suggestion was approved, and member Knapp agreed to see that an appropriate article would be prepared.

Discussion also took place on the importance of future meeting(s) to inform the public of our findings. The time, location, and format of these meetings would be arranged after consulting with the Selectmen and Chiefs for their input. It was suggested by Committee Member Evans that these future meeting(s) be held at the Tuftonboro School in a location large enough to handle the expected attendance as a result of the interest displayed by the public on this topic.

A motion to adjourn the meeting was made, seconded, and approved. The meeting was adjourned at 8:04 p.m.
