Re: February 2011 Arrests

Since January 1, the Tuftonboro Police Department has made 13 arrests. The February arrests were:

February 5, at approximately 6:37 PM, John Levasseur, of Canaan Road, was arrested and charged with Criminal Threatening and Criminal Mischief. Over 20 weapons and destructive devices were seized upon service of a restraining order. The Tuftonboro Police Department is working with the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) and US Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) on this case.

On February 9, at approximately 7:00 PM, Jeri Anderson of Old Woods Road was arrested on an arrest warrant from the Conway Police Department.

On February 10 at approximately 5:05 PM, the Tuftonboro Police executed a search warrant and arrested Shane O'Connell of Wakefield at a residence on Governor Wentworth Highway. It was the result of an investigation into suspicious activity in the area. O'Connell had active arrest warrants from the Wakefield and Wolfeboro Police Departments including charges of Possession of a Controlled Drug, Driving after Suspension and Resisting Arrest. There were also 3 bench warrants and 2 Superior Court capiases for his arrest. The bench warrants were for Theft by Unauthorized Taking, Possession of Controlled Drugs and False Reports. Other outstanding cases O'Connell faces are Class A felony Theft by Unauthorized Taking and Failure to Pay Child Support.

On February 18 at approximately 6:05 PM, a resident was taken into custody on a prayer and complaint for an involuntary hospitalization for a mental evaluation. A Tuftonboro officer was with him at Huggins Hospital until after 12:00 AM.

On February 24 at approximately 11:07 AM, the Tuftonboro Police Department assisted NH Probation and Parole and the Carroll County Police arrest a parolee who was accused of violating terms of his parole. The maximum he can return to the state prison is 90 days.

On February 24 at approximately 4:44 PM, Corey Shaw of Union Wharf Road was arrested on an arrest warrant from the Gilford Police Department. He was charged with Receiving Stolen Property.

On February 24 at approximately 5:48 PM, Angela Shaw of Union Wharf Road was arrested on an arrest warrant from the Gilford Police Department. She was charged with Theft by Unauthorized Taking, Simple Assault, Disorderly Conduct, Receiving Stolen Property, and 2 counts of Robbery
