We covered much to do with the Community Garden and the first year of “no till” plus Composting.

Geoff:

- how to deal with rule breaking....consequences? ie: insecticides, etc.
 - perhaps best to have a note on the contract that the participants sign
 - may be a transition issue and not a long term problem
- communication cumbersome
 - initial yes to shared email or opt out
- potato and eggplant moratorium?
 - YES for the present, revisited yearly
- compost material - many unable to turn compost, many not in the habit, and amount of raw material
 - raise level of first bin, use blocks from the rest
 - end of season, build a holding pile on pallets for air beyond the shed, in 2 yrs it will be ready, so the next yr. a new one, back and forth

- compost biggest problem - participation
 - solution: 3 work days folks can show up to help, include in the contract
