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Selectmen's Meeting Minutes 8:30 am – Tuftonboro Town Offices Monday, August 16, 2021

Present: Chairman Bill Marcussen, Selectman Chip Albee, Selectman Guy Pike and Administrative Secretaries Cathy Pounder and Cami Wakefield.

CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Marcussen called the Selectmen's meeting to order at approximately 8:37 am.

NON-PUBLIC

APPOINTMENTS

The Selectmen reviewed the roads with Road Agent Jim Bean. The following roads were discussed:

Lamprey Ln – needs ditching/culvert.

Pine Mill Rd – may need work soon

Ledge Hill Rd – needs culvert replaced and large cracks repaired.

Cannan Rd – back side of the hill to the dirt section needs work. It was dished in the wear path.

Tupek Rd – missing road sign.

Lang Pond Rd – Conservation Commission Board members Steve Wingate and Steve Scapicchio joined to review the road condition. Road needs shoulder repair and rip rap to be put in at the dam checks. Storm water runoff needs to be cleaned by box culvert.

Tuftonboro Neck Rd – shimcoat only done approximately 14-15 years ago. Washout observed on intersection of Tuftonboro Rd and Cross Neck Rd.

Hurlbert Rd.- reviewed

Shirley Way – needs to be crushed and re-done, road agent will send past quote to the Selectmen.

Harvest Ln – drainage issues
