Monday, April 4, 2022

CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Albee called the Selectmen's meeting to order at approximately 4:30pm and lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

REVIEW & APPOVAL OF MINUTES

Selectman Pike made a motion to approve the 3.28.2022 BOS meeting draft minutes as amended. Selectman Murray seconded; motion carried 3-0.

APPOINTMENTS

Chris Ruel – Transfer Station – presented the attached update.

Steve Scapicchio and Steve Wingate updated Selectmen on the status of the Conservation Commission and the purchase of the Sodom Rd property. Steve Scapicchio said they are closing on April 14, 2022 and will need a check for \$60,000 to bring to the closing.

Steve Fusco and John Ratcliff came in to stress their concern about a motor cross track that has been set up on the power lines on Mountain Rd on the Vittum property. Selectman Pike removed himself from the conversation as he is in favor of the track and too biased to be involved. Steve Fusco noted that his property is only about 20 feet from this property where the track is and that he has had a decimeter outside, and the noise level has reached 120 decibels. Chairman Albee said that noise problems have come up in the past and that usually the best solution is a mutual accommodation. Chairman Albee also added before we can make any sort of determination, we are going to have to talk to Town counsel and stressed that he really hoped that some sort of accommodation can be made.
