A discussion of the reversal of the Abandonment of the Thompson-Moulton Cemetery resulted in the decision that Guy and Sue would set up a conference call with Attorney Mark Puffer to clear up some details. It was noted that signage needs to move forward as a cross country ski trail was observed in the Townhouse Cemetery recently. Discussion resulted in the decision that Guy will make up a proposed list in the absence of Sexton Steve Honeycutt who is seriously ill. The Trustees are seeking help until he can return.

Peter Sluski will present the Cemetery Expendable Trust Fund Warrant Article at Town Meeting.

Rights of Burial apaerwork was received for Edwin Thomas and Patricia Luby.

Sue will talk to Diane about a check from the Haleys made out to the Cemetery Trustees. It is suggested that they wait until after Town Meeting to pay.

Sue and Guy have been inventorying the number of plots in the Town House Cemetery and verifying the Cemetery's maintained by roger Williams to determine the distribution of perpetual care funding in the future. This will continue.

A revised Deed will be sent to attorney Puffer and forwarded to Karen who is the point person for the public.

Thomas Chiappisi has indicated a desire to s lloyd a cemetery plot back to the Town. The Trustees will initiate the procedure after their conference call with Attorney Puffer.
