Old Business

- Community Garden
 - Year-end questionnaire: Still need to get a list of snail mail addresses for the 2020 gardeners,

 - Wildflower seeding: Will probably have to wait till early spring before the ground is bare again.
 - Approval of 2021 CG Application: Sue will give Bill the proposed new garden rates to bring before the selectboard for approval.

 - Spring Garden Opening: The Fall Clean-Up was so successful we need to have a similar event for opening. Can pick a date (Late April, early May) and include it in the CG application?
- Master Plan Update: Sue is on the Steering Committee for the town master plan update, and wants TAC members to be thinking what will be important to focus on for the town re agriculture (includes forest management) to be included in the update. Discussed whether we should consider town-wide composting as a future goal. Need to do additional research about how similar sized towns are doing thin in the state.
