Review of MJB Special Revenue Account: No updated report was received. A January 14, 2021 MJB email account

status report was received from Kathryn Carpentier (Wolfeboro Finance Director) showing \$25,762.95 in the account. The report did not include the \$8,870.00 received from the sale of the

DASH. The total in the account as of January 28, 2021 would be \$34,632.95.

Old Business: 1. DASH unit update:

The completion of the DASH sale has taken place with the Bill of Sale completed and signed by both parties. The next step will be to await a date in the spring for the Lakes Environmental Association (LEA) to pick up the DASH from Lanes End Marine Services in Tuftonboro.

New Business: 1. <u>Discussion and decision on the distribution of funds from the sale of the DASH:</u>

After a discussion period, Linda Murray made a motion to: "Await the passage of a Wolfeboro and Tuftonboro 2021 Town Warrant Article to transfer \$17,000.00 to each town from the Milfoil Joint Board's Reserve Account to Tuftonboro and Wolfeboro's Milfoil Reserve Accounts." Bill Marcussen seconded the motion. Marschner, Wingate, Marcussen and Murray voice voted in the affirmative. The motion passed.

The MJB's reserve account will have approximately \$316.47 remaining in the account to use for additional expenses, if incurred, before the Milfoil Joint Board disbands this coming summer.

Other Business: 1. Public Input: No other persons present.

2. When the DASH is picked up by the LEA in the spring, they will bring a current Maine boat

registration sticker and a new trailer license plate.

Murray. Marschner, Marcussen, Murray and Wingate voice voted in the affirmative.
