

The Town of Tuftonboro is looking for dedicated community-oriented individuals to join our police department. We are presently looking for applicants to fill a full-time officer vacancy. We are also looking for certified officers to fill a part-time vacancy on a temporary basis. The Town of Tuftonboro is an equal opportunity employer offering a competitive compensation package. The salary is \$21.74 to \$28.69 depending upon training and experience. The positions require shift work, including nights, weekends and holidays. Certified officers are encouraged to apply. The closing date is September 28, 2018.

Qualifications: Applicants must be of good character, at least 21 years of age, citizens of the United States, have a high school diploma or equivalent, have a valid New Hampshire driver license, and able to meet all hiring and certification requirements established by the NH Police Standards and Training Council. A background investigation will be conducted prior to employment. Applicants are expected to be able to work cooperatively with co-workers and the public under sometimes stressful circumstances.

The hiring process may include a written test, oral interviews, physical test, medical exam, drug test, psychological exam, and polygraph exam. Some tests may be waived for officers with a current New Hampshire certification.
