

MILITARY VETERAN HEADSTONES AND MARKERS

The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) furnishes, upon request, at no charge to the applicant, a Government headstone, or grave marker, for the unmarked grave of any deceased, eligible Veteran, in any cemetery around the world, regardless of the date of their death.

For eligible Veterans that died on or after Nov. 1, 1990, and whose grave is marked with a privately purchased headstone, the VA may also furnish a headstone or marker to supplement the grave, or a Medallion to be affixed to the privately purchased headstone.

To receive a headstone, marker or medallion, the eligible applicant must submit a VA Form 40-1330 (headstone) or VA Form 40-1330M for a marker or medallion, to the VA , along with proof of military service.
