Compost Material	Leaves, pine needles	See attendant for instructions.	None
Tires	Tires from cars, trucks, motorcycles, bicycles, lawn tractor tires, etc	Remove tire from rim.	Truck \$10 Cars \$4 Other \$2

Everything else	Other non-hazardous household trash not mentioned above.	No animal wastes may be placed in compactor. Save paint and other hazardous material for special collection.

Mixed & newspaper	Junk mail, magazines, newspaper, gloss inserts, computer paper	Bundled, bagged or loose	None
Plastic bottles & jugs	Beverage containers, milk jugs, etc.	Rinse	None
