

Tuftonboro Free Library CLOSED Effectively Immediately due to Covid-19

Effective immediately, the library is closed to the public, and Inter-library Loan service is suspended. Patrons can still search the online catalog and request materials by phone or email. Staff will deliver checkouts to patron vehicles between 1 and 2:30 p.m., Wednesday-Sunday. We ask that patrons hold onto checkouts until the library reopens -- please do not return materials to the book drop.

Ebooks, audios, movies, TV shows, music, magazines, and comics are available for free download/streaming through Hoopla and Overdrive. Access these services from the library website with a valid library card. Just call if you need your 14-digit account number.

Free 24/7 Wifi service will continue to be accessible from the parking lot.

This closure is in force through April 7th at least. The Trustees will reassess the situation at that time. We hope that these steps will help to ensure the sustained good health of our community, which is our primary concern.
